DESCRIPTION

Prestige Flowable Screed is a rapid setting, shrinkage compensated cement-based self-levelling compound. It has been specifically formulated for the levelling and smoothing of rough or uneven substrates prior to the installation of floor coverings in high trafficked areas. Its rapid setting, high strength formulation has been designed to repair cement-based sub-floors including sand/cement screeds, and concrete floors. Once applied, the compound can be subject to light foot traffic after 2 to 3 hours, and floor coverings – such as epoxy coatings, tiles, vinyl and carpet – can typically be installed 24 hours after application, once the moisture content is 3% or less.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Surface preparation

- Existing surfaces must be solid, firm and free of dust, mould oil, grease, sealers, wax polish and organic growth. All damaged, defective, deteriorated or hollow sounding areas within the screed or render must be removed down to a solid, clean substrate and made good before screeding Organic growth must be removed, and the spores killed with an effective fungicide such as a household bleaching solution.
- 2. Enamel-painted and bitumen surfaces: Strip all of the coating by scraping and then chip to expose 80 % of the substrate. DO NOT USE A SOLVENT OR HEAT TO REMOVE BITUMEN FROM THE SUBSTRATE.
- Porous surfaces/substrates should be dampened prior to applying Prestige Flowable Screed. Highly porous surfaces must be primed with Prestige Keying Additive prior to screeding.
- 4. Smooth, off-form/shutter or power-floated cement surfaces must be acid wash to remove laitance and rinsed well with cold clean water. Once the surface preparation has been completed on the above problem surfaces, the area must be primed with Prestige Keying Compound mixed with Prestige Keying Additive. (Two parts of Prestige Keying Compound to be mixed with one part of Prestige Keying Additive and applied with a builder block brush to a minimum thickness of ± 2mm). Apply screed while keying slurry is still tacky.

Mixing

- Mix 20kg of Prestige Flowable Screed to ± 5 litres of cold clean water. In wet, permanently wet or special conditions, replace all the water in the mix with Prestige Bonding Additive.
- 2. Mix to a creamy smooth paste. Mechanical mixing will result in a lump free, easier to use mix. Stir occasionally whilst in use.
- 3. Allow mix to activate for 5 minutes. Remix product before use. DO NOT ADD MORE WATER.
- 4. Do not mix more screed that can be used in ± 30 minutes

Application

- 1. Pour the **Prestige Flowable Screed** onto the primed substrate, spreading it out with a long handled pin leveller or notched rake suitable for the required thickness, until the entire surface is covered
- Trowel marks and wavy surfaces can be removed with coarse sandpaper or a corundum stone after the screed is dry.
- 3. Drying times will vary between 1-hour and upwards depending on thickness of the screed, addition of Bonding additive, and temperatures prevailing at the time.
- 4. Screeds above 5mm thickness must be allowed to dry overnight prior to laying any floor coverings or before applying water sensitive adhesives.
